Material Characteristics

Lacquered finishes are handcrafted on E1/Carb2 MDF panels using water-based paints, with a polyester base for humid environments. For glossy lacquers, the process also involves direct lacquering in multiple layers, ensuring a uniform, excellent, and long-lasting shine.

No odor, no styrene emissions: everything is water-based and completely natural to the touch. The product is non-toxic and harmless to humans, animals, or the environment. The MDF panels used are E1/Carb2 certified, with limited formaldehyde emission.

Colors may show slight shade variations compared to the sample in our lacquered color swatch due to material differences and reflections. Such tolerances are considered accepted when placing an order.

Care and Maintenance Instructions

To always keep the surface in the best condition, it is recommended to pay particular attention to the maintenance phases of the artifact.

Recommendations:

- Use a soft cotton or microfiber cloth and non-abrasive liquid detergents.
- All operations must be carried out carefully to avoid scratching or polishing the surface.

Not recommended:

- Avoid products containing ammonia, acetone, chlorine, solvents, and abrasive products.

CAUTION: Do not use cleaners containing ammonia and/or solvents and ethyl alcohol, regardless of their concentration and even if diluted, as they tend to attack the material. Avoid rough and abrasive sponges, metal pads. Coffee and tea can permanently stain the product.
